Staff work collaboratively and in partnership with parents/carers to ensure all students leave our school with many options.

We aim to ensure that every one of our students reaches their academic potential, and our student leadership programs are producing of leaders of the future.

The school has a Targeted Sports Program (TSP) where we balance academic AND sporting success.

Our High Expectations Policy has been implemented to ensure students are performing academically in order to participate fully in the Targeted Sports Program and extra curricular activities. Students need to meet three criteria in order to experience the full benefits of the Targeted Sports Program. Students need to record above 90 percent attendance, exhibit consistently good behaviour and complete all their academic tasks. If students do not meet these three criteria their involvement in the TSP and extra curricular activities is restricted until the next review.

Research shows that talented athletes tend to have above average intelligence and can have both academic and sporting success.

There are many opportunities at our school that assist in the achievement of academic excellence, such as STEM, Coding, Gifted and Talented field trips, debating, public speaking and student leadership opportunities.

A HSC mentor, who has a doctorate in raising student achievement, is for those in the critical senior years.

PRINCIPAL

The Principal of Endeavour Sports High School is entrusted with the education of some of the brightest and most talented students in the country. Endeavour is a dynamic, innovative and future focused school with a range of opportunities for students to experience success within and beyond the classroom. The strategic leadership of the Principal is instrumental in guiding the school's executive and teachers to reach the highest of standards in teaching to enable every student to reach their academic potential. The Principal ensures that at Endeavour we have academic success firmly embedded as our number one priority in all that we do.

SENIOR EXECUTIVE

The Deputy Principals support the Principal in providing both strategic and day to day leadership of the school. Our Deputy Principals are responsible for specifically designated areas, including innovation in technology, teaching and learning, improvement and compliance processes, human resources, parent and community relations. In addition, the Deputies monitor student and staff wellbeing, academic performance and sporting achievements. They also conduct High Expectations Reviews and deliver whole school professional learning programs to continually improve teaching and learning outcomes.

DIRECTOR OF SPORT

The Director of Sport is responsible for the Talented Sports Programs and the performance of all elite athletes, coaching programs and sports competitions.

The Director of Sport coordinates day to day sport organisation, delivers professional learning for the Talented Sports Program, and oversees coaching and wellbeing in the sporting arena.

HEAD TEACHERS

Head Teachers are our subject masters. Academic departments are led by Head Teachers, who are responsible for each curriculum area, teaching programs, assessment and reporting. Head Teachers monitor and report student academic performance and review all academic programs of study. Head Teachers work collaboratively with teachers to develop, enhance and innovatively teach programs that maximise student learning outcomes.

YEAR ADVISORS

Year Advisors are the first point of call for students when they need advice, direction and assistance with concerns. They accompany the students on camps and excursions to build rapport with students. Year Advisors and teachers care for and value each student. Parents are welcome to contact Year Advisors at any time for a report on a student's learning progress.

WELLBEING MENTORS

Mentors collaborate with students each day to deliver study skills and wellbeing programs. Mentors work with groups of students to ensure they maximise their learning opportunities and in the classroom and beyond to ensure they engage successfully across the school.

COUNSELLORS

Counsellors provide valuable support, counselling and psychological assessment for students with specific needs. Their daily work includes counselling students, assessing students' learning and behaviour, helping families make informed decisions about their child's education, identifying impediments to students' learning and liaising with external agencies regarding students' wellbeing.

HOMEWORK TUTORS

A selection of teachers from Endeavour assist students as homework tutors by providing individualised support to understand and complete coursework, homework, projects or tasks.

LEARNING SUPPORT TEACHER TEAM

Learning Support Teachers are experts in assisting teachers in the classroom. They have experience in supporting English as an additional language or dialect (EAL/D) learners and students with learning difficulties. They work closely with teachers to identify students requiring additional support to access the syllabus content and employ strategies to maximise learning.

CAREERS ADVISOR

The Careers Advisor provides guidance and advice to help students explore their education and career options, create a resume, search for jobs, apply for jobs or apply for further study. The CA also liaises with parents, teachers, employers, community agencies and training providers. They have a wealth of knowledge to guide students into successful tertiary pathways.

LIBRARIAN

Our Librarian supports students with research and study skills. The Librarian provides assistance for students to successfully complete tasks, projects and coursework. Access to technology, books, websites and printing are all part of the library's facilities.

EXPERT TALENTED SPORTS COACHES, PHYSIOTHERAPISTS, STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACHES

Students are coached by highly qualified experts in Talented Sports Programs, and engage in strength and conditioning. Students also have access to physiotherapists and Sports Scientists. Sydney FC have an office in Endeavour Sports High School and major partnerships exist with the likes of the Sydney Swans, Cronulla Sharks, Hockey NSW, Cricket NSW, Netball NSW, Baseball NSW and Basketball NSW.

PATHWAYS TO FUTURE CAREERS

There are many curriculum study patterns for students to take to prepare them for future pathways in tertiary education, TAFE and the workplace. Endeavour offers two distinct pathways for students to explore their strengths and interests to prepare them for future careers.

The Higher School Certificate is a program of study with English as the only compulsory subject. The students have access to a wide range of academic and vocational school based courses, TAFE courses and traineeships. Students in Years 11 and 12 can choose from over 35 courses.

Various subjects involve major projects and performances, and also involve a combination of internal and external assessment.

Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses are dual pathways that provide students with the opportunity to achieve a HSC and nationally recognised Certificate II or Certificate III qualifications in areas of student interest. Traineeships and apprenticeships can also be accessed for interested students.

Vocational Education and Training (VET) in Schools and at TAFE (TVET) can be studied as part of the New South Wales HSC course. They provide credit towards a nationally recognised VET qualification within the Australian Qualifications Framework and are used to qualify for the HSC and in some cases contribute to a student's ATAR. VET and TVET opportunities continue to play an important role at Endeavour and provide students with a real alternative to the traditional HSC.

Careers coaching and academic mentoring for inspiration and study success are available for all senior students. Seniors participate in a structured mentoring program which is focused on subject choices, study techniques, student organisation, time management and motivation to achieve their academic personal best.

OUR STEM EDUCATION PROGRAM OFFERS OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LEGO ROBOTICS CHALLENGE, ANSTO STEM CHALLENGE AND UNIVERSITY SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING CHALLENGE.

Elective STEM courses are offered for year 9 and 10 students to explore Information Systems and Engineering. SENIOR STUDENT EXECUTIVE


The students and staff of Endeavour Sports High School elect 2 Captains and 2 Vice-Captains as well as 4 senior prefects to lead and represent the school for the following 12 months. Their duties require them to act as positive role models and display school leadership both within the school and in the community.

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL (SRC)

The SRC is comprised of student representatives from Years 7-11, elected by their peers and staff. They actively work within the school community, acting as leaders in developing a responsible and caring school environment.

PEER SUPPORT

Selected Year 10 students receive training and support in conducting peer support sessions to assist Year 7 students in their transition to high school. Mentors work in pairs to conduct team building and social skills sessions with small groups of Year 7 students under the supervision of teachers.





EXTRA-CURRICULAR

STUDENTS ALSO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC SPEAKING, DEBATING, PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE, CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP, DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD, MIND MARATHON, ANSTO SCIENCE CHALLENGE, ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS AND SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS, INCLUDING BAND AND ENSEMBLES.

Endeavour Sports High School offers students in Year 9 to Year 12 the opportunity to participate in The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award.

The Award is an enriching program that invites young people to participate in a number of activities over a set length of time. Participation is entirely voluntary and is structured so students can design their own unique program centred on their interests and passions.

Students are able to participate in three award levels: Bronze, Silver and Gold. Each award has four sections, Physical Recreation, Skills, Service and Adventurous Journeys.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is about setting goals. These goals are realised with persistence, determination and resilience and will see the student become better prepared for life's challenges in the future.

Our successes since introducing this award have enabled ESHS the opportunity to meet with Prince Edward as part of the 60th anniversary of the Award operating in Australia. The students also participate in adventurous journeys operated by the school itself.





HIGH PERFORMANCE UNIT

THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN NSW, THE HPU HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED TO SUPPORT THE TARGETED SPORTS PROGRAM. THE VISION BEHIND THIS INITIATIVE IS TO CREATE AN INTEGRATED ONE-STOP-SHOP APPROACH TO PROVIDING OUR STUDENTS IN THE TSP WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO ACCESS HEALTH AND PERFORMANCE SPECIALISTS, LARGELY ONSITE AT ENDEAVOUR, OUTSIDE OF AND DURING SCHOOL HOURS.

The Endeavour Sports HPU provides sports medicine, sports science and strength & conditioning to our student athletes, optimising their athletic development by further supporting their performance needs.

Through our affiliations and partnerships with highly qualified, experienced and in-demand professionals in their chosen fields, the HPU has assembled, arguably, one of the best sports science teams in the country.

Student athlete medical and support services include physiotherapy, massage therapy and dietetics located in our Sports Science Centre on the grounds of Endeavour Sports High School during scheduled hours. Other services including performance psychology, podiatry and sports medicine - made available by referral to local off-site providers.





FACILITIES

- 1. Our completely refurbished library provides an educational space with flexible learning areas, enhanced access to technology and a welcoming environment for a variety of teaching and learning activities.
- 2. The High Performance Unit brings the latest in services provided by sports science health professionals to our student athletes: physiotherapy, sports medicine, elite massage therapy, sports nutrition and psychology.
- 3. The Sports Science Centre not only incorporates the HPU but also provides Australian Institute of sport standard strength and conditioning facilities.
- 4. Our Cricket High Performance Centre is undoubtedly one of the best training facilities in Southern Sydney.

- 5. The 5 Sports facility located on our grounds is used exclusively by our students throughout the school day. Providing a full-sized artificial turf field and dozens of mini-fields, it is a world class sporting facility.
- 6. Our Athletics Hub includes an international standard running track, long jump pit and throws circles.
- 7. Other high performance facilities include a multi-purpose indoor gymnasium, two multipurpose outdoor courts, two tennis courts, an undercover basketball court, a full sized rugby league/union field, a smaller sized cricket and AFL oval and a dance studio.
